### Parent Evaluations

SAUSD Parent Workshop – Santa Ana High School – May 18, 2011

Key objectives of this pilot workshop were for parents-of-teens to learn:

- Information about why teen parenting is problem for the lifelong wellbeing of children
- How teen parenting also impacts the teens’ future and their parents’ quality of life
- The mission and an overview of the ESP (Education for Successful Parenting) program in the schools
- How parents can engage their teens in thinking about these issues

Instruction: 90 minutes. Program delivered in Spanish.

Survey results from **35 parents with children age 7-18 who are not teen parents, after ESP’s workshop**

Are you likely to talk to your children about waiting until adulthood before becoming a parent?	Percent
<b>I do not want to talk</b> with my child(ren) about this	0%
It is <b>unlikely</b> I will talk with my child(ren) about this now, but <b>maybe later</b>	0%
<b>It is very likely</b> I will talk to them <b>within 2 weeks</b>	100%

Has this class given you information and strategies that will help you talk with your children about waiting to become a parent?	Percent
<b>Yes, a lot – I think this class has helped me a lot</b>	91%
<b>Yes, a little – I think this class has helped me a little</b>	9%
<b>No – I don’t think this class has helped at all</b>	0%
